

China National Day Tour from Shanghai

TOUR

October 2 – 5, 2017 3.5 nights in the DPRK

OVERVIEW

Escape Shanghai over China National Day and see the highlights of Pyongyang on many walks through the city!

Come on a short break to DPRK over China National Day! This tour includes a comprehensive city tour of Pyongyang, covering the must-sees such as the Mansudae Grand Monuments, the mausoleum where Kim II Sung and Kim Jong II lie in state as well as the Victorious Fatherland Liberation War Museum. Apart from that this tour will get you walking through the streets of East Pyongyang and down the newly constructed Mirae (Future) Street and take you to the lively town of Pyongsong where you'll be able to jump in on an English class at Kim Jong Suk Middle School.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Pyongyang city walks
- Kumsusan Memorial Palace (Mausoleum of leaders), Victorious Fatherland
 Liberation War Museum and other Pyongyang highlights
- Panmunjom/DMZ the border with South Korea
- Ride the Pyongyang Metro and drink in a local beer bar

Please note that the itinerary may differ slightly to what is below but your tour leader will do their best to ensure that as much is covered as possible and will also add in extras when there is time such as a visit to a local bar or a funfair. We visit the DPRK regularly and know all the best places to go to make your trip even more unique. We will make the most of your time in the DPRK to guarantee the experience of a lifetime.



DAILY ITINERARY

OCTOBER 1 - SUNDAY (BRIEFING & DEPARTURE DAY)

PM

 Meet your Koryo Tours tour guide and fellow travelers at Shanghai Pudong Airport for a pre-tour briefing and check-in for your late night flight to Pyongyang. This briefing will last approximately one hour and is designed so that you will get the most out of your tour. It will cover travel etiquette, safety, and practicalities for travel in the DPRK. Have your last minute questions answered and meet your fellow travelers.

OCTOBER 2 - MONDAY (ARRIVAL IN PYONGYANG & CITY TOUR)

AM

- Early morning arrival at Sunan Airport, Pyongyang and transfer to hotel for breakfast and a rest
- Mansudae Grand Monuments Enormous bronze statues of President Kim II Sung and Leader Kim Jong II overlooking downtown Pyongyang. A presentation of flowers and bow by the group is customary here (5 EUR). Here we will also see the Chollima Monument, or 'thousand ri (400 km or 250 mile) horse' a symbol of speed commemorating the quick rebuilding of the country in the 1950's following the Korean War.
- Walk from Pyongyang's Grand Theatre to Kim II Sung Square Pyongyang's central square lined with government ministries, museums, and The Grand People's Study House.
- Foreign Languages Bookshop Store selling Korean publications translated into English, German, French, Russian, Chinese, and Spanish. Also pick up DVDs, postcards, and small works of art.

PΜ

- Pyongyang Metro Tour One of the deepest metro systems in the world with stunning artwork reflecting the name of each station. Ride six stations on the Chollima Line.
- Mangyongdae Native House Birthplace and childhood home of President Kim II Sung. A traditional Korean house in beautiful natural surroundings.
- Victorious Fatherland Liberation War Museum Tour this world-class museum led by a local museum guide. Renovated in 2012 and its exhibits of Korean War from the DPRK perspective containing artifacts, documents, photos, and lifelike dioramas. The exterior grounds house the War Victory



Monument and displays of Korean People's Army Hero Equipment and captures equipment from the US military, including the USS Pueblo. Central to the understanding of the country today and highlight of the trip.

• Taedonggang Bar No. 3 - Upscale bar across the street from the Tower of the Juche Idea. There are a variety of beers on tap produced at Pyongyang's Taedonggang Brewery outside of town (2-2.5 EUR per glass).

OVERNIGHT

Yanggakdo International Hotel, Pyongyang - home away from home for most (but not all!) foreign visitors to Pyongyang, this 47-story hotel is located on an island in the middle of the Taedong River and offers great views of the city. Comfortable rooms and comprehensive leisure facilities: swimming pool, spa, billiards, bowling, gift shops, tea houses, beer brewed on-site, and a Chinese-run casino.

OCTOBER 3 – TUESDAY (PYONGSONG & PYONGYANG)

AM

- Drive north to **Pyongsong**, a satellite city of Pyongyang and centre of scientific research. *A 45 minute to 1 hour drive*.
- Pyongsong City Square Central square of Pyongsong City with statues of the DPRK leadership and flanked by the provincial revolutionary museum. Presentation of flowers customary.
- Kim Jong Suk Higher Middle School One of the DPRK's top middle schools for gifted students, tourists are encouraged to help teach an English class!

PΜ

- Drive back to Pyongyang for walk in East Pyongyang A walk on the other side of the river past:
- The Tower of Juche Idea Iconic tower dedicated to the DPRK's guiding philosophy on the Taedong River. Take the elevator to the top for great views of the city (*elevator ticket is 5 EUR*).
- Monument to the Party Foundation Iconic structure featuring the hammer, sickle, writing brush which represent the workers, farmers, and intellectuals that make up the Worker's Party of Korea.
- **Taesong Department Store** Local department store in East Pyongyang with domestic and foreign made products. Small bakery inside.



• Golden Lane Bowling Centre - Where Pyongyang locals go for their ten-pin fix (2.5 EUR per person per game). Also has billiards and arcade games. Non-bowlers can head next door to the Kumrung Leisure Centre for an air gun shooting range (approximately 6 EUR per 20 round cartridge) and some of the best coffee in Pyongyang.

OVERNIGHT

Yanggakdo International Hotel, Pyongyang.

OCTOBER 4 – WEDNESDAY (KAESONG & DMZ TOUR)

AM

- Drive south along the 'Reunification Highway' to Kaesong, historic capital of the Koryo Dynasty (918-1392) and today located near the Korean Demilitarised Zone. A 2.5 hour drive.
- Panmunjom Truce Village Located in the middle of the 4 km wide
 Demilitarised Zone, Panmunjom is the site of the signing of the 1953
 armistice at the end of the Korean War. This is the only location where
 visitors can directly view soldiers from both sides and the demarcation line
 dividing Korea. On some days it is possible to enter the hut straddling both
 Koreas and there cross temporarily into the south.
- Kaesong Koryo Museum Once the Songgyung Academy, a Confucian school, and now a museum on the Koryo Dynasty exhibiting historical objects, statues, pagodas, and porcelain from that era. A UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Kaesong Korean Stamp Exhibition Hall Store selling stamps, postcards, local ginseng, souvenirs, art, and more! One of the best postcard collections in the country and friendly staff.
- Traditional Royal Korean Lunch (pangsanggi) A meal made of 12 dishes served in brass bowls fit for the kings of old. The more dishes, the more distinguished the guest! Traditional Korean 'sweet meat soup' is an option here (5 EUR).

PM

- Old City Walk and South Gate A stroll through Kaesong's historic district lined with homes dating back to the late Ri Dynasty to the city's historic South Gate.
- Tomb of King Kongmin Tomb of the 31st king of the Koryo Dynasty, a talented statesman and prolific painter, and his Mongolian wife set at the end of a picturesque valley. A UNESCO World Heritage Site.



- Drive back to Pyongyang with a stop at the Monument to the Three Charters of Reunification, a large stone archway over the highway memorializing joint agreements between north and south. 2.5 hour drive
- Taedonggang Bar No. 3 Upscale bar across the street from the Tower of the Juche Idea. There are a variety of beers on tap produced at Pyongyang's Taedonggang Brewery outside of town (2-2.5 EUR per glass).

OVERNIGHT

Yanggakdo International Hotel, Pyongyang.

OCTOBER 5 - THURSDAY (PYONGYANG CITY TOUR)

AM

- Kumsusan Palace of the Sun -Mausoleum of the DPRK leadership where President Kim II Sung and Leader Kim Jong II lie in state and the most solemn location on the itinerary. Please note formal dress is required. Men require collared shirt with tie, dark non-jean pants, and dark shoes. Women require covered shoulders, knee-length dress or pants, and closed toed shoes. The visit will take most of the morning and visitors are asked to bow a number of times inside. This is a state administered site and visits are subject to local conditions. Cancellations are rare but possible.
- Revolutionary Martyrs' Cemetery -Hilltop cemetery with dozens of bronze busts of those who took part in the liberation of Korea from Japanese colonial rule. It is customary to present flowers here.

PM

- **Kwangbok Department Store** Opportunity to use Korean currency and shop with the citizens of Pyongyang! Try the snack stand on the first floor for some of Pyongyang's best local eats.
- Science and Technology Centre Newly built atom-shaped educational facility, library, computer lab, and exhibition of the latest developments in science and technology.
- **Future Street** Walk in the newly built residential district for scientists and academics to view its unique modern architecture.
- Duck Barbecue Restaurant South Pyongyang's famous grilled duck restaurant that has seen many teary-eyed farewells.
- Transfer to Pyongyang airport for late evening flight back to Shanghai with scheduled arrival at Shanghai Pudong Airport at approx. 11:30pm
